Ngayong 2016, tatlo ang tema na idineklara ng ating Inang Simbahan upang pagnilayan natin ang biyaya ng pag-ibig ng Diyos sa ating kasalukuyang buhay. Mula sa Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines, dalawang tema ang iminungkahi para sa ating mga Pilipinong Katoliko Kristiyanong Pamilya at Taon ng Eukaristiya. Mula sa bibig ng ating pinakamamahal na Santo Papa Francisco, ang Taon ng Awa at Habag ang kanyang iminungkahi para sa ating lahat. Iminungkahi ng CBCP ang Taon Para Sa Mga Pamilya itong taong 2016 upang pagnilayan natin ang kahalagahan ng pamilya bilang batayan ng

simbahan o *domestic church* na buong loob na inaalagaan ng ating Inang Simbahan sa kabila ng mga kasamaan na sumisira nito - contraception, paghihiwalay o divorce, marital infidelity, cohabitation (live-in partnership), fornication (pre-marital sex), abortion, at homosexual unions (kasama dito na isinusulong ng samahan ng mga Lesbian, Bisexual, Gay, and Transsexual o LGBT). Iminungkahi rin ng CBCP ang Taon Para sa Banal na Eukaristiya dahil layunin ng ating Inang Simbahan na hindi lamang natin pagnilayan bagkus isabuhay ang mga alintuntunin, aral, at diwa ng isinagawang 51st International Eucharistic Congress sa Cebu City noong Enero 24-31, 2016. Higit sa lahat, iminungkahi ni Papa Francisco itong taong 2016 bilang Taon Ng Awa at Habag upang mas lalo nating maunawaan at tanggapin ang lalim at laki ng dakilang awa ng Diyos para sa ating mga makasalanan - na ipinapahiwatig na mas hinahangad ng Diyos Ama na patawarin tayong lahat kung tayo'y lalapit at hihingi ng kapatawaran sa Kanya kaysa parusahan tayo sa mga nagawa nating mga sala. Subalit, ang tanong: sa paanong paraan natin ipagkakaisa ang tatlong tema na iyan upang maging isa?

Pagkatapos ng taimtim na pagninilay, napagtanto ko na isang salita ang magbubuklod sa tatlong tema nito: Eukaristiya! Sa pagtanggap ng Banal na Eukaristiya tuwing Linggo bilang isang pamilya, mas lalong tumitibay ang pagkakaisa ng pamilya dahil si Hesukristo na tinanggap nila ay Siyang nagbubuklod sa bawat kasapi ng pamilya sa isa't isa. Sa pagtanggap ng Banal na Eukaristiya tuwing Linggo, nararanasan natin ang awa at habag ng Diyos Ama na nagsasabing: "Kahit ilang ulit kang madapa sa pagkakasala mo, ilang ulit din kitang patatawarin sa mga kasalanan mo basta laging kang magsisisi at hihingi ng kapatawaran mula sa akin." At sa pagtanggap ng Banal na Eukaristiya tuwing Linggo, tayo'y nagiging Hesukristo (at dapat lang maging Hesukristo) sa iba dahil tayo at si Hesukristo ay nagiging isa. Tuwing tumatanggap tayo ng Banal na Eukaristiya sa Banal na Komunyon, nagiging bahagi ng buhay natin si Hesukristo at tayo'y nagiging bahagi ng buhay ng ating Poong Manunubos. Kaya, kailangang makita sa ating pagkatao si Hesukristo na nagpapatawad, nagmamalasakit, at nagmamahal sa kapwa kahit sino pa man siya.

Kaya, sa taong ito, tayo'y laging magsimba upang tumanggap ng Banal na Komunyon Linggo-linggo upang makilala si Kristo na nagmamahal at nagpapatawad sa ating pagkatao ng iba, at ating akayin ang ating mga pamilya sa pagsisimba upang makilala at tanggapin si Hesukristo na lubos na nagmamahal sa ating lahat.

Firmly believing in the one-liner “The Lord Will Provide”, the two have, nonetheless, not relaxed and simply await the fall of “manna from heaven”. Working hard they are, and you cannot imagine how these two are doing it, alongside with their respective daytime work responsibilities. They are not leaving any stone unturned!

Anne is the youngest in the brood of four of the couple Connie and the late Jun Santos. Anne is her Dad’s baby: the pampered, the well-loved and carefully-guarded one who started Church work in high school as Lector to fulfill a school requirement in Parish Involvement. 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MUNTING KATESISMO

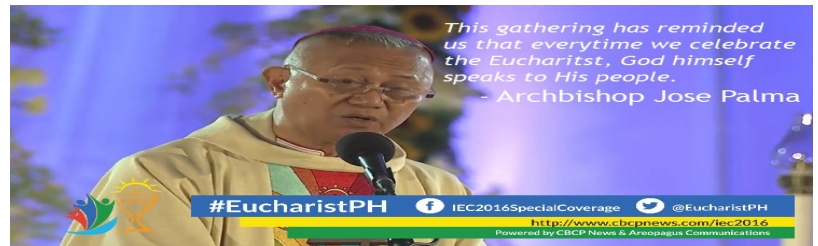
